ALL SUNDAY GATHERINGS & EVENTS HAVE BEEN CANCELLED FOR APRIL 5 & APRIL 12.

While we won't be meeting for the next two weeks, we do want to continue to trust and lean on Jesus as our source of hope and joy in the midst of this trial. We still want to fight the temptation to fear or panic regarding that which may destroy the body, but cannot destroy the soul (Matt. 10:28). The best way for us to continue to look to Jesus is to look to him together as a church and encourage one another in the gospel!

We will be adjusting some of our regular rhythms as well as adding a few new rhythms over the next couple weeks to help us look to Jesus together and encourage one another:

Sunday Worship Video and Guide: We will continue to send out our Worship Packet on Sunday mornings. Beginning April 5, our Worship Packet will include a video devotional sermon from our pastors. This video devotional will be designed to point us to Jesus and help us gather as a church while we are scattered.

Community Group Meetings via Zoom: Beginning this week, our Community Groups will be gathering via Zoom. Community Groups will gather online each week during their normal day and time for connection, Scripture and prayer. Your Community Group Leader will be sending an invitation to the Zoom gathering along with additional information and instructions.
